Joint Action Project

Supplier Renewable Energy for Apparel & Footwear sector - Vietnam

This project supports apparel and footwear manufacturers in Vietnam to transition to renewable energy, reducing supplier-level and Scope 3 emissions. By leveraging shared suppliers across brands operating in Vietnam, the initiative accelerates clean energy adoption through cost optimization, demand aggregation and knowledge sharing.

Why this project matters

- **Critical sourcing hub:** Vietnam, world's 2nd largest garment-textile exporter, is critical for global brands net zero commitments, and is a significant contributor to Vietnam's annual carbon emissions (8-10%).
- **Strength in collaboration:** Collaborating with brands to leverage shared suppliers can help lower costs, aggregate demands and accelerate clean energy uptake.
- **Strategic advantage:** Supplier decarbonization strengthens competitiveness, resilience, and leadership in a market increasingly defined by sustainability

Expected results

- Reducing carbon emissions for suppliers while reducing value-chain emissions for brands they cater to.
- Leveraging common suppliers helps reduce costs and incentivizes scale.
- Creating capacity-building programs for suppliers to make informed decisions about the implementation of renewable energy solutions.
